## We Need To See The LORD!

Purpose: to encourage our church family to seek God's face in order for us to see ourselves, be cleansed and be used by Him.

As we go further in the book of Exodus we are now about to get to the battle between darkness and light - the children of Israel against the children of Egypt. We are going to see how Moses battled with Pharaoh to free the Israelites from slavery. However, today before we go further I need to re-emphasise with clarity the message that God has given us so far. This is very important.

Four things happened to Moses that prepared him to do God's will and defeat the enemy:

- Moses saw the LORD (Exodus 3:6 the burning bush)
- Moses saw himself (Exodus 3:11)
- Moses is cleansed by God (Exodus 4:24-26; the circumcision)
- Moses is used by God (Exodus 4:30

The same thing happened to Isaiah:

- Isaiah saw the LORD (vs. 1-4)
- Isaiah saw himself (v. 5)
- Isaiah was cleansed by God (vs. 6,7)
- Isaiah was willing to be used by God (v. 8)

The same happened to Job:

- Job saw the LORD (Job 38:1-3)
- Job saw himself (Job 42:5,6)
- Job was cleansed by God (Job 42:7)
- Job was used by God (Job 42:8,10)

This is what God wants to do with us all:

- He wants us to see His face
- He wants us to see ourselves
- He wants to cleanse us
- He wants to use us.

Will you seek His face? Will you let Him do it?
